



ITHALA EDUCATION FUND

SELECTION CRITERIA

The aim of Ithala Education fund is to assist academically- deserving, historically disadvantaged youth who cannot afford to pay registration fees, to access tertiary education. Ithala Education Fund provides registration fee funding for First Year students only.

The following selection criteria apply;

1. The combined annual income of the beneficiary's parents or legal guardian should be LESS than R150 000.
2. The beneficiary must have an acceptance letter from the tertiary institution/college they wish to be enrolled at.
3. Beneficiaries must be able to demonstrate financial need and academic potential.
4. Funding will only be awarded for registration fees for the first year of study.
5. Students from rural and previously disadvantaged communities should be prioritized.
6. Only applications with all the required supporting documentation will be considered.
7. Funding may only be awarded to South African citizens with a valid South African ID number.
8. Registration fee funding will be paid directly to the tertiary institution.
